Use the pages in order. Each page builds on a skill and vocabulary used in the previous page. This packet includes the following:

- 1. Identify Colors (2 pages)
- 2. Mix primary colors (1 page)
- 3. Mix secondary colors (1 page)
- 4. Match colors to the English and Hindi words (2 pages)
- 5. Color the Rainbow (1 page)
- 6. Identify color couplets (2 pages)
- 7. Match color couplets to the English and Hindi words (2 pages)
- 8. Start Speaking! Build sentences using key verbs and repetitive phrases (3 pages)
- 9. Make your own flashcards! Practice common verbs: to be, to have, to see, to like (2 pages)

You, the parent, the native or familiar Hindi speaker, are the teacher. Sit with the child to help them learn. The phonetic English-Hindi phrases are approximations, and are only a guide. Kids will learn proper pronunciation and emphasis by listening to a native speaker. Keep talking and start building their confidence in speaking by trying out the simple phrases at the end of the packet. Use the flashcards to help! Go slowly, don't finish the packet in one sitting. Knowledge retention is built over time and through repetition. We hope these tools help empower you to reinforce language learning at home, and ultimately, help to grow your multilingual family.






