

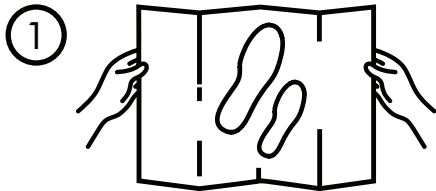
Setting Up Your Size Guide

You'll need: A4 size paper, a printer, sticky tape, and a ruler.

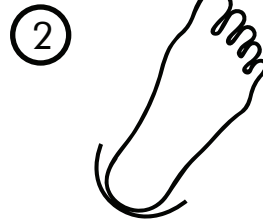
Print out your guide. Ensure the print settings for the document are adjusted to "Actual Size" proportions or equivalent.

Tape your two paper sheets together. Ensure the scale lines on **both sides** of the page measure **30cm** when joined, and the scale on the **bottom left corner** measures **5cm**. This will indicate your pages have been printed and attached at the correct scale to find your perfect fit.

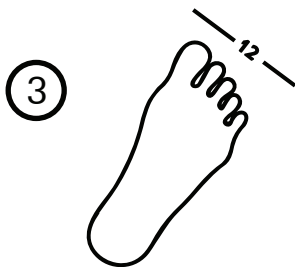
Finding Your Perfect Fit



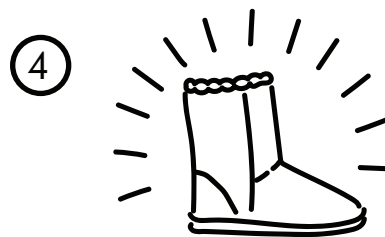
Lay your size template flat on the ground. A flat surface will work best. Remove any footwear and/or socks.



Place the heel of your foot in line with the black line on the size chart marked below. Stand up, and ensure your foot is flat on the chart.



Locate the black line in front of your longest toe. The size marked on that line is your correct size.



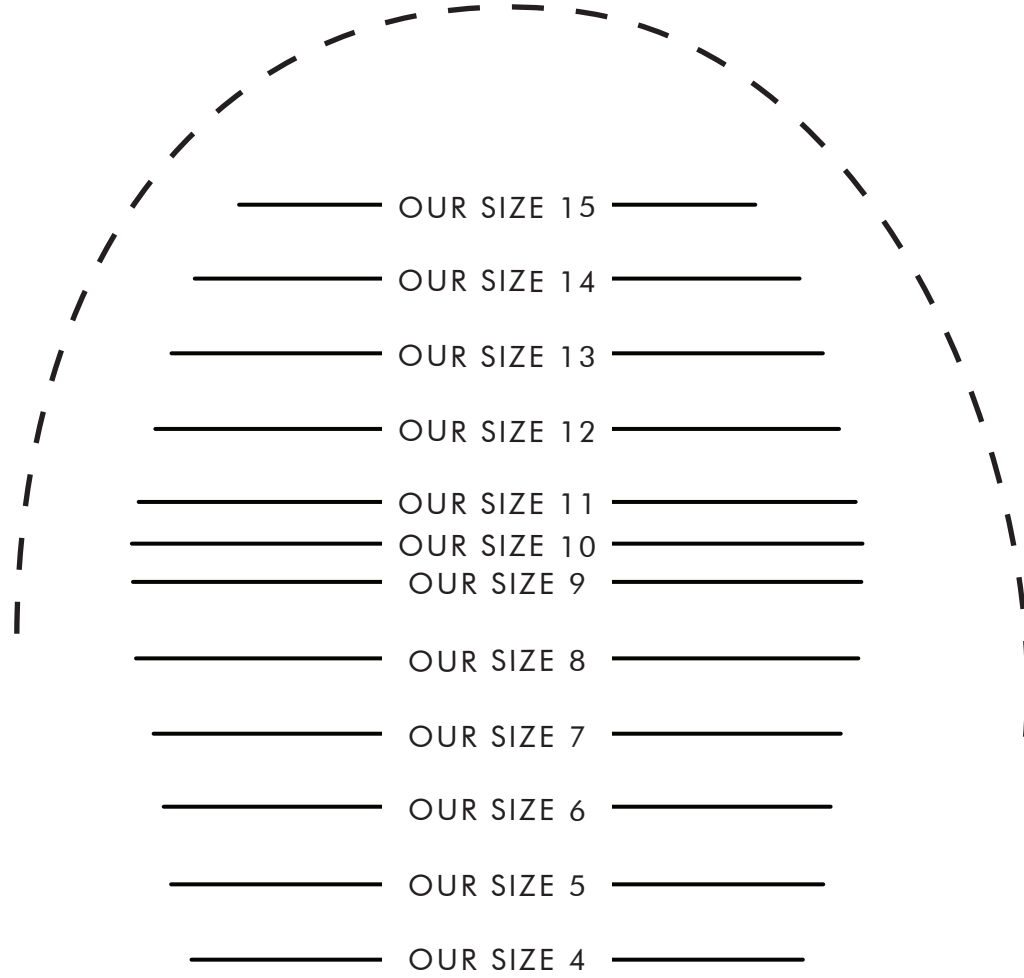
Order your new pair of sheepskin boots tailored to the perfect fit.
