

NBees is a V4.1 Bluetooth Neckband Headphone supporting multipoint connection and voice prompts in English.

#### OVERVIEW of NRees

#### RODUCTION

Thank you for purchasing Jabees NBees Bluetooth Neckband Headphone. This manual will help you to accurately operate NBees, but you also should familiarize yourself with the Bluetooth function of your mobile phone or other devices before using the Bluetooth headphones NBees

### **CHARGING UP NBees**

- 1. Plug the USB charging cable into the right side USB charging port of NBees.
- 2. When charging begins, the LED indicator light will be red.
- 3. When the battery is fully charged, the LED indicator light will be blue.

### WHEN THE BATTERY IS LOW

When you hear the voice prompt "Battery Low", please charge your NBees Bluetooth Neckband Headphones.
Battery meter on iPhone and other iOS devices.

#### IMPORTANT

- · Charge NBees before your first use.
- You should recharge NBees if it has not been used for more than 12 months.
- . Use only the included USB charging cord to charge NBees.

## MULTIFUNCTION BUTTON

Answer/End/Reject/Transfer calls; Mute; Play/Pause Music; Redial; Factory Reset.

# TURNING NBees ON/OFF

# To turn NBees on:

Slide down ON/Off Switch. The blue LED light flashes with a voice prompt. The headphones are now turned on.

### To turn NBees off:

Slide up ON/Off Switch. The red LED light flashes with a voice prompt. The headphones are now turned off.

PAIRING NBees WITH A MOBILE PHONE

- 1. After turning on the NBees, the LED light flashes in red and blue with a voice prompt "Pairing" in about 10 seconds. NBees is now in pairing mode. Or manually press MF button for 5 seconds after turning on NBees, until LED light flashes in red and blue with a voice prompt "Pairing". 2. Activate Bluetooth function on your mobile phone.
- 3. Set your phone to discover NBees. 4. If password or PIN-code is required, confirm with 0000.

#### PAIRING NRees WITH THE SECOND MOBILE PHONE

- NBees supports multipoint technology, which means that it can be paired and connected with two Bluetooth-enabled mobile phones and use at the same time. 1. Activate Multipoint function:
- When NBees is turned on and not connected with any devices, short press the MF button and Volume Down button simultaneously.
- 2. Pair and connect NBees with the first mobile phone.
- 3. Turn off the Bluetooth function of the first mobile phone and NBees.
- 4. Turn on NBees and pair with the second mobile phone. Turn off NBees.
- 6. Turn on the Bluetooth function on first mobile phone.
- 7. Turn on NBees again and it will automatically connect to the first mobile phone, then manually connect the NBees with second mobile phone (some mobile phones can be automatically connected).

NOTE: If you need to disable the Multipoint function, please short press the MF button and Volume Up button simultaneously.

Once NBees is successfully connected to your mobile phone, you can use it to make and receive calls. The headphones can be used with voice dialing if your mobile phone supports this feature. Please consult your mobile phone's manual for more information.

1. Noice Dallaire

Press MF button about 2 seconds and dial by speaking contact's name after hearing the voice prompt "Voice Dial".

2. Normal Dialing
Enter and dial the number on your mobile phone as you normally do. Once the call has been set up, the

sound will be transmitted to your headphones automatically.

3. Redial
Double click MF button to redial the last number you called.

### ANGLESING (ENDING (DELECTING CALLS

ANSWERING/ENDING/REJECTING CALLS

When the headphones are turned on and connected with the mobile phone, and there is an incoming

call, you will hear a musical tone.
-Press MF button to answer the call.

-Press MF button to end the call.

-Long press MF button for 2 seconds to reject the call.

### TE

During phone calls, short press both MF and Volume up button simultaneously with a "beep" to put call on mute. Repeat the step above to un-mute the device.

# VOICE BROADCAST FUNCTION

NBees supports voice prompts and reading incoming number.

To transfer a call to the mobile phone, press the MF button about 2 seconds and the blue LED light flashes with a voice prompt "transfer audio". If you want to transfer the call back to NBees, press MF button for 2 seconds again. More procedures may be involved for some mobile phones.

# PUT THE CALL ON HOLD

Double click MF button to put the current call on hold and accept the call waiting. Double click MF button to put the second call on hold and resume the first call.

# ADJUSTING THE VOLUME

You can increase/decrease the volume by adjusting Volume Up/Volume Down button of NBees or your mobile phone.

Press Volume Up button" \( \bar{\pi} \) " to increase the volume;

Press Volume Down button " \ " to decrease the volume.

# PLAYING/PAUSING MUSIC

Press the MF-button to play or pause music. Long press Volume Down button "\" for 2 seconds to play next song:

Long press Volume Up button "₹" for 2 seconds to play previous song.

# CONNECTING WITH A DC OF BDA

You can connect NBees with a Bluetooth-enabled PC or PDA that supports headphones or hands free profiles. Please refer to the user manual of your Bluetooth-enabled PC or PDA for setup information.

FACTORY RESET

When NBees is turned on and not connected with any devices, press the MF button and Volume Up button "₹" simultaneously for 5 seconds, the LED light flashes in red and blue with a voice prompt "oower off", now the factory reset is successful.
