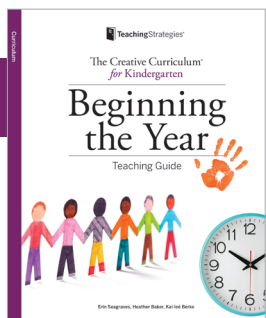


The Creative Curriculum® for Kindergarten Children's Book Collection: A Look Inside
