

PLANKING: To be of good length cedar (or Philippine Mahogany) in as long and narrow strakes as possible, 7/8" (or 3/4" thick). To be tight on the inside, and with narrow and uniform caulking seams. All fastenings to be bunged. Entire hull to be planed off and well sanded to a smooth surface.

DECK: Deck to be 3/4" marine plywood or planked with 7/8" white pine or Douglas-fir, either caulked and payed or covered with #10 canvas laid in white lead paste.

CABIN TOP: To be 1/2" marine plywood or 3/4" matched boards covered with #10 canvas laid in white lead paste.

COCKPIT: Cockpit sole to be 1-1/4" teak or 3/4" marine plywood.

**Note: Planking and frame to be treated with Cuprinol.
