## HULL MATERIALS

## NOTES

Wood is hardwood, except possibly for thwarts, floorboards, stern sheets. About 40 board feet are needed
(ie: 12 m of $300 \times 25 \mathrm{~mm}$ ). Most parts can be finished out of $4 \times 1^{\prime \prime}$ boards.
Sizes are finished. (Building Frame etc sizes are approx.)
Min. extra is allowed for waste.
Strips for laminating are best clean sawn, not planed.


## PLYWOOD

3 sheets of $8^{\prime} \times 4^{\prime} \times 3 / 16^{\prime \prime}(5$, or 6 mm ) mahogany marine plywood.

## GLUE

West Epoxy 'A' Pack - 2 1/4 lbs. - and 205 Hardener.
Microfibres - Silica - Mixing Sticks - Measuring pumps or syringes - West Manual - hand cleaner.

## FASTENINGS

Silicon Bronze Countersunk Woodscrews:
40-11/2" x 8 ( $40 \times 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ ) - hog, keel, gunwales, knees, c-case, thwarts, skeg, breasthook.
20-11/4" x 8 ( $30 \times 4 \mathrm{~mm}$ )-gunwale, sternsheets
$16-1 " \times 10 \quad(25 \times 5 \mathrm{~mm})$ - rowlocks
$3-21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10(60 \times 5 \mathrm{~mm})-$ skeg
$30-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \quad(20 \times 5 \mathrm{~mm})$ - floorboards
'Gripfast' bronze nails: $100-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16$ (12mm fine) for planking.
