## HULL MATERIALS

All sizes are finished. Minimum extra is allowed for waste.

The more substantial softwoods work well for practically all parts: Douglas fir, Port Orford cedar/Lawson cypress, yellow pine etc. Or lighter hardwoods: mahogany, ash, etc. Keel and gunwale rubbing strake could be hardwood. Softwood floorboards may be fitted over light floors as in Wee Rob.
