

# YOUR BIRD FEEDER

## LOCATION

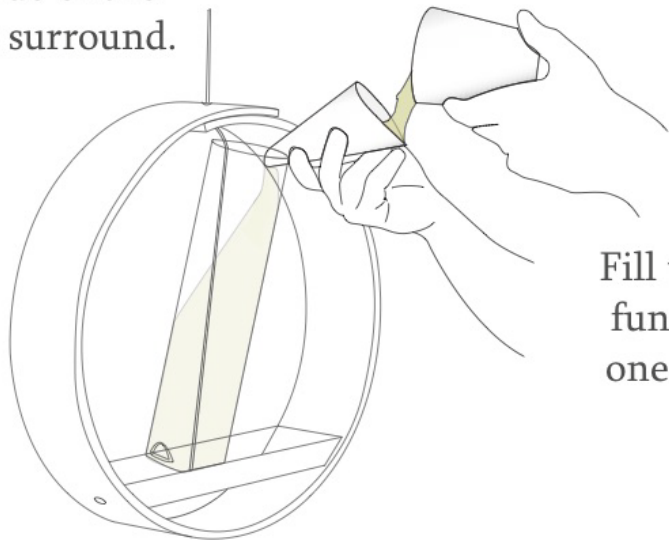
Hang close to natural shelter such as trees or shrubs, this offers a safe resting place for birds in between feeding.

When you first set up a feeding station, you may not have many visitors. Be patient, the local birds have to discover the new food source.

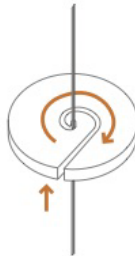
## USE

Lift and twist off the cap at the top of the tube.

Tilt the tube slightly to one side of the wooden surround.



Fill tube using a funnel or make one from rolled up paper.



Straighten the tube and twist top cap back into position so that it drops down and seals the tube.

## COMPONENTS

This bird feeder comes with two inserts for use with mixed seed. To adjust the flow of food into the tray, different size inserts can be used.

Fine seed - both inserts

Small/Medium seed - large insert

Medium seed - small insert

Large seed - remove both inserts

## CLEANING

To maintain the longevity of your bird feeder, simple cleaning is recommended. When the tube is due to be refilled, remove left over seed and run water through the tube and seed tray. Alternatively, a damp cloth can be used. Allow to dry thoroughly before re-filling.

More thorough cleaning of the tube can be carried out by completely dismantling the feeder. The cable can be removed from the metal hook by pushing the shaft. Please wear gloves as the cable ends can be sharp.
