Tips to avoid tears

The Pixi Newborn Parent Facing Pack is designed and tested to comply with Consumer Protection Notice No. 8 of 2007, AS 2088:2022 and AS/NZS ISO 8124-3.



DO NOT USE THIS SEAT WITH ANY OTHER MODELS OF STROLLER.

Age & weight limits:

 Maximum age and weight limit for a child in the Newborn Parent Facing Pack is 22kg, although we recommend this be used from newborn to 6 months.


General safety:

- This newborn pack is approved for use with the Milly + Coup Pixi range only.
 Do not use with any other products.
- Always ensure the newborn pack is securely attached before using the stroller.
- Ensure the harness is fastened at all times while your child is in the stroller.
- Supervise your baby at all times.
- Do not use for unsupervised sleeping.
- Never leave the UV cover over the stroller indoors, in a hot atmosphere or near a heat source.




- 1 Base

Removing the stroller seat


Ensure the seat is in the fully upright position and remove the belly bar.

Behind the canopy, undo the elastic loops connecting the canopy to the frame on either side of the handlebar.




Lift the leg rest fully upright to meet the seat backrest so that you can access the underside of the seat.

Undo the zip wrapped around the metal bar.




Undo the strap below the zip and un-thread each end out through the slots in the plastic.



To remove the canopy, press the button on the outside of the canopy connectors (A) and pull out from the frame.


Below the canopy connectors are the seat connectors (B). To remove these press the release tab on the **inside** of the connectors and then pull them out.



Removing the stroller seat

You can then pull the seat fabric upwards and off the frame.

Note: There is a fabric slip (A) that keeps the seat on the frame, this may get stuck as you try to lift off the seat. Simply guide it over the footrest levers to release.




You're now ready to attach the newborn pack!


Attaching the newborn pack

Starting with the frame in the position shown, fold the newborn pack in half ensuring the harness is facing towards the handlebar (it is a parent facing seat).




- Slide the fabric slip over the footrest levers and onto the metal frame.
- Thread both straps through the slots on the plastic.







- Pull the end of the strap with the Velcro through the ring on the end of the other strap and fasten together.
- Pull the head end of the base down firmly so that you feel it lock into place on the frame.



Note: you may need to flip the stroller to be able to access underneath.





Attaching the newborn pack


At the other end of the base, secure the seat connectors into the plastic connector slots on both sides of the frame.


Note: Ensure you connect these into the lower of the two slots.


To attach the canopy, place the elastic end of the canopy over the head end of the base and secure underneath the base using the Velcro. Secure each of the canopy connectors to the upper slots on both sides of frame.

Note: these are the same slots that the belly bar would normally slot into for the stroller seat

To fold the canopy, grip the middle canopy rod and pull down to avoid excess fabric in the top of the base.







Your newborn pack is now set up and ready to go!

Folding with the newborn pack


Pixi can be folded with the newborn pack attached.


- Undo the Velcro strap from underneath that is connecting the underside of the seat to the stroller frame.
- Pull the entire canopy and base back up to meet the handlebar.
- Simultaneously push the lock button (A) and the release button (B) while pushing the handlebar forward so that the stroller folds onto itself.

handle and avoid lifting with a bent back.

 Ensure the frame lock has engaged before lifting and carrying.







Removing the newborn pack

Press the button on the sides of the canopy connectors before pulling them out to remove the canopy.


Press the button on the inside of the seat connectors and pull them out of the sockets.




Undo the Velcro of the small strap that is wrapped around the stroller frame and lift the seat upwards to release it from the frame.



Undo the Velcro strap and un-thread it back through the slots in the plastic as shown.



While holding both ends of the newborn pack, pull it up and off the frame.




Re-attaching the stroller seat


Start with the frame in the position shown.




Secure the canopy connectors into the upper connectors slots on both sides of the frame



Behind the seat, secure the elastic loops on each side of the canopy to the handlebar frame.




Attach the seat connectors below the canopy connectors into the lower slots.





Lift the base of the frame up towards the handlebar and slide the seat's fabric slip over the footrest levers and all the way down the frame.

Re-attaching the stroller seat

- Make sure you thread the footrest levers through the holes in the fabric. It should now look like the image shown.
- Next, thread each Velcro strap through the slots in the plastic attachment arms. Pull the strap with the Velcro end, through the other straps' metal buckle and secure them together.
- Secure and close the zip around the metal bar
- Pull the seat base and footrest firmly down and secure it in place on the frame.
- Insert the belly bar to the frame.








To attach the UV cover

- Place the elasticated edge of the UV cover over the edge of the canopy and secure the toggle on each end through the loop on the side of the canopy.
- Attach the elastic loops on the opposite end of the UV cover to the round clips on the frame underneath the handlebar.
