

DOMAINE DU BOUCHOT Pouilly-sur-Loire 'Mon Village' 2021

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Provenance: Pouilly-sur-Loire, Loire Valley Grape Variety: 100% Chasselas

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Pairing: Burrata, tomatoes, grilled goat cheese with figs, Purslane salad with seafood and pickled onions 04

Serving: Temperature: 12°C



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Vineyard Cultivation:

A family estate since 1966, Domaine du Bouchet is 10 hectares in size and has been crafting wine for decades, with the latest owner being Antoine Gouffier. Taking over Domaine du Bouchot in 2018, the young winemaker and his wife have brought great energy and modern views to the traditional region of Pouilly-Fumé. These vines are located in St. Andelain in the southern part of Pouilly Fumé close to the Loire River.



Vinification:

The harvest is by hand, the yeasts are indigenous and the wine is made with as little pumping as possible. Aged on its fine lees in 500L barrels, the wine is bottled in the spring after a very light filtration.



Tasting Notes:

There's a delightful gingery edge to the citrus and ripe melon fruit on the nose, which follows through to the medium-bodied palate, coloring the wine from start to finish. 100% Chasselas. From biodynamically grown grapes with Demeter certification. Unfiltered. A fun wine to drink now. 90 pts, James Suckling.
