

DOMAINE TABORDET Pouilly-Fumé 'l'Autre Rive' 2021

Provenance:

Pouilly-Fumé, Loire Valley

Grape Variety:

100% Sauvignon Blanc

Pairing:

Platter of shellfish or a dry goat cheese

Serving: Temperature: 12°C



Vineyard Cultivation:

In the village of Verdigny, Domaine Tabordet was formed from 4.5 hectares of vines in the 1960s by Raymond Tabordet. Later passed onto his two sons, Yvon and Pascal in 1981 the estate began to expand to the appellation of Pouilly-Fumé. Today Marius Tabordet, along with his cousin Gaël operates the domaine under the guidance of Pascal. Marius monitors the vines, performs the vinification, and bring to life the signature of Tabordet within their expanding domaine of 16 hectares in Pouilly-Fume and 5 hectares in Sancerre.



Vinification:

The grapes are carefully picked and selected from the vines by hand. The wine is aged in stainless steel tanks and matured on its lees for 18 months.







Tasting Notes:

A slightly smoky style that offers amplitude and rounded edges. The 2018 Pouilly-Fume L'Autre Rive is modestly concentrated. The ripe fruit is starting to shed its primary characters and head into a developing phase of almond and lanolin. Rather languid on the finish, with 14% alcohol and relatively gentle acidity leaving a sensation of weight. 86 points, Rebecca Gibb, Vinous. (2018 review)
