EXTERIOR DIMENSIONS


29.5" (L) x 20.5" (W) x 23.5" (H)* *24.5" (H) with removable carry handles

Exact dimensions may vary slightly due to the rotational molding manufacturing process.







KENNEL HANDLE ASSEMBLY


INCLUDED HARDWARE

- •1x 5/8" Hex Key






Use the short side of the 5/8" Hex Key for additional torque to ensure the handle is installed tightly.




SECURING YOUR KENNEL

The Gunner Tie-Down Strap Kit are the only ones the company recommends, and have met each of the brand's crash test standards, including the Center for Pet Safety G1TM crate and carrier 5 Star Crash Test Rating. We recommend securing your kennel at all times during travel. Connect the tie-down straps as shown below and tighten. Ensure the kennel is properly anchored before travel. Check that the kennel is poperly secured each time before traveling with your dog.

- Connect each 8' tie-down strap to each corner of the G1™ kennel.
- Ensure the straps feed through an appropriate anchor point in the truck bed or cargo area of your vehicle.

ROTATING YOUR KENNEL DOOR



Gunner Kennels assembles each G1[™] Small and G1[™] Medium kennel prior to shipping. If upon receiving your kennel you prefer that your door open from the opposite direction, follow these tips:

1. Using a phillips head screwdriver, remove the striker plate for the aluminum door frame.

2. Use a 3/16 allen wrench to remove the 6 socket-head cap screws.

3. Flip the door around, reinstall the 6 socket-head cap screws.

4. You will want to take a phillips head screwdriver to remove the Gunner Kennels logo plate and reinstall on opposite side.

If you have trouble lining up the bolts after you take them out you can loosen the body bolts on the four corners of the door.
