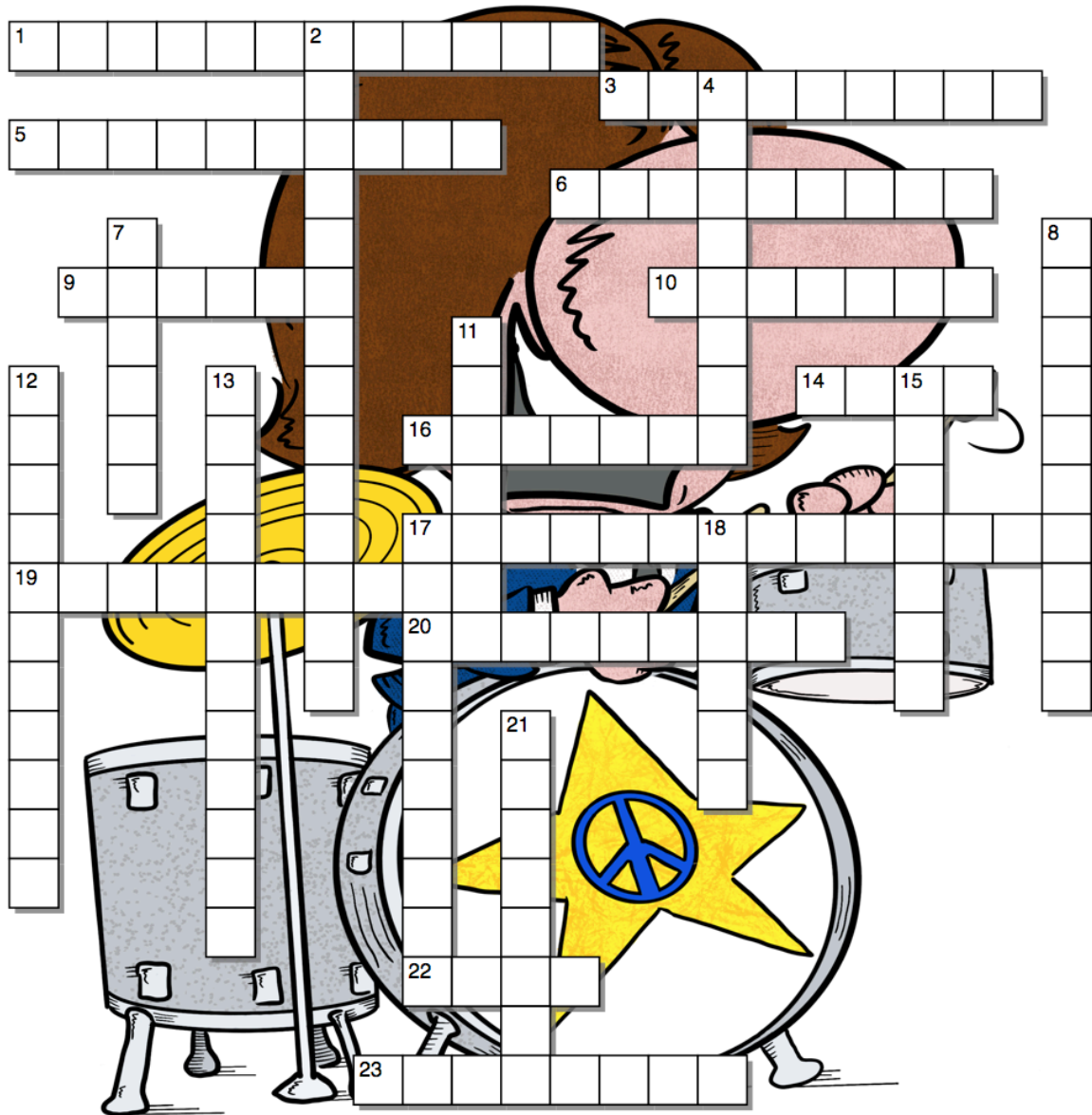

- 1) Originally a campaign song for Timothy Leary's run for Governor in California
- 3) The first George Harrison song to be released as a Beatles single on the A Side
- 5) Written as a last minute addition to the Yellow Submarine film, then cut out in the US released version of the film
- 6) The Beatles reaction to the civil rights movement

- 9) George Harrison penned tune that opens *Revolver*
- 10) Influenced by Beethoven's *Moonlight Sonata*
- 14) John's lyrical response to The Beatles' fame
- 16) Paul's song of comfort and the Apple Label's first release
- 17) Little Richard cover
- 19) The world is at his command
- 20) Released in 1965, this song features only one Beatle on it.
- 22) John's reaction to people complaining about the weather
- 23) Debut single featuring John Lennon on harmonica

- 2) Abbey Road song inspired by a Thomas Dekker poem published in 1603
- 4) Single from Rubber Soul featuring French lyrics
- 7) He took your canary and he fed it to the neighbors cat
- 8) Uses Road Runner sounds in it's lyrics
- 11) George Harrison's ode to self centered-ness
- 12) Bryan Adams would release a different song with this same title 19 years later
- 13) The Beatles 7th consecutive Number One hit in the US
- 15) Often mistakenly thought of as having Biblical inspiration
