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Extension Description

This extension is an elder brother of our Attribute Description Tooltip extension, which serves as a solid foundation for the PRO version. With this extension you can add descriptions/hints to any attribute or custom option. When an attribute (or custom option) has a description, it will have an info icon created next to it. When the icon is hovered, a tooltip will popup with a description in it. This will save space on the page, and the design will remain clean, as those descriptions will become visible only when the customer needs them.

Features

- It adds descriptions/hints to any attributes and custom options on the store.
- Descriptions can be chosen to appear on catalog page or/and on product page.
- Content of a description is highly customizable in terms of images, layout, fonts and colors due to WYSIWYG editor utilization.
- Ability to upload a custom info icon to conform to website design.
- Ability to add different content for a description for different Store Views.
- Ability to add attribute descriptions for configurable products.
- Ability to choose when to show the tooltip: on hover over the icon, on click on the icon, or on hover over the attribute together with the icon.
- Ability to specify desired tooltip positioning.
- Ability to turn on/off fade effect.
- Ability to replace the default info icon with a custom one.
- Tooltip is visible even when the mouse pointer moves away from info icon to the tooltip area. This means that now it will be possible to select/copy all content within the tooltip, and also links will be now clickable.
- It also has an improved tooltip script and now it's possible to configure whether you need the tooltip to pop-up on hover over the info button, or on click on it.
- Ability to add descriptions both to custom option titles and to custom options items.
- Custom Options Snippets functionality will let you create description templates. These templates may be utilized for custom options in a seamless and instant way. You won't need to manually enter or copy-paste again and again same descriptions. They will always be handy – just one click away. Select the right template – and it will instantly autofill the description box.

Extension Installation and Configuration

1. Unpack and copy all extension files to the Magento root folder.
2. In Magento Admin Panel navigate to *System*→*Cache Management*. Select and refresh all cache types.
3. Log out of Admin Panel and then log back in.
4. Navigate to *System*→*Configuration*→*Webtex*→*Info* section. There you should find Attribute Description Tooltip extension in the list of installed extensions.
5. This is it! Extension has successfully been installed.

Working with the Extension

1. Extension Admin Options

To adjust the appearance of this extension navigate to *System*→*Configuration*→*Webtex*→*Attribute Description Tooltip*. There you will find options, reflected of the following screenshot:

- **Activate Description Tooltip** field lets admin to choose whether he wants to enable this extension for Layered Nav and/or Product Page, or to disable it.
- **Tooltip Positioning** field has 10 options of tooltip positioning.
- **Fade Effect** and **Transparency** implement such fancy effects as fade effect and transparency.
- **Change Default Icon** gives an ability to upload an Info icon of your choice to conform to website design.

2. Adding Description for an Attribute

To add a description for a given attribute:

- Go to Admin Panel and navigate to *Catalog*→*Attributes*→*Manage Attributes*.
- Select from the list an attribute you want to add description for.
- Now on the Edit Product Attribute page click on Manage Description tab.
- From there you will be able to input attribute description for your store views (see screenshot below).

3. Using Attribute Description in Layered Navigation and on Product Page

If you've selected to display tooltips in Layered Navigation, then the result of adding description in section 2 will look like as follows (when user cursor is over the Info icon):

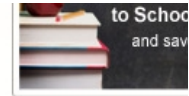

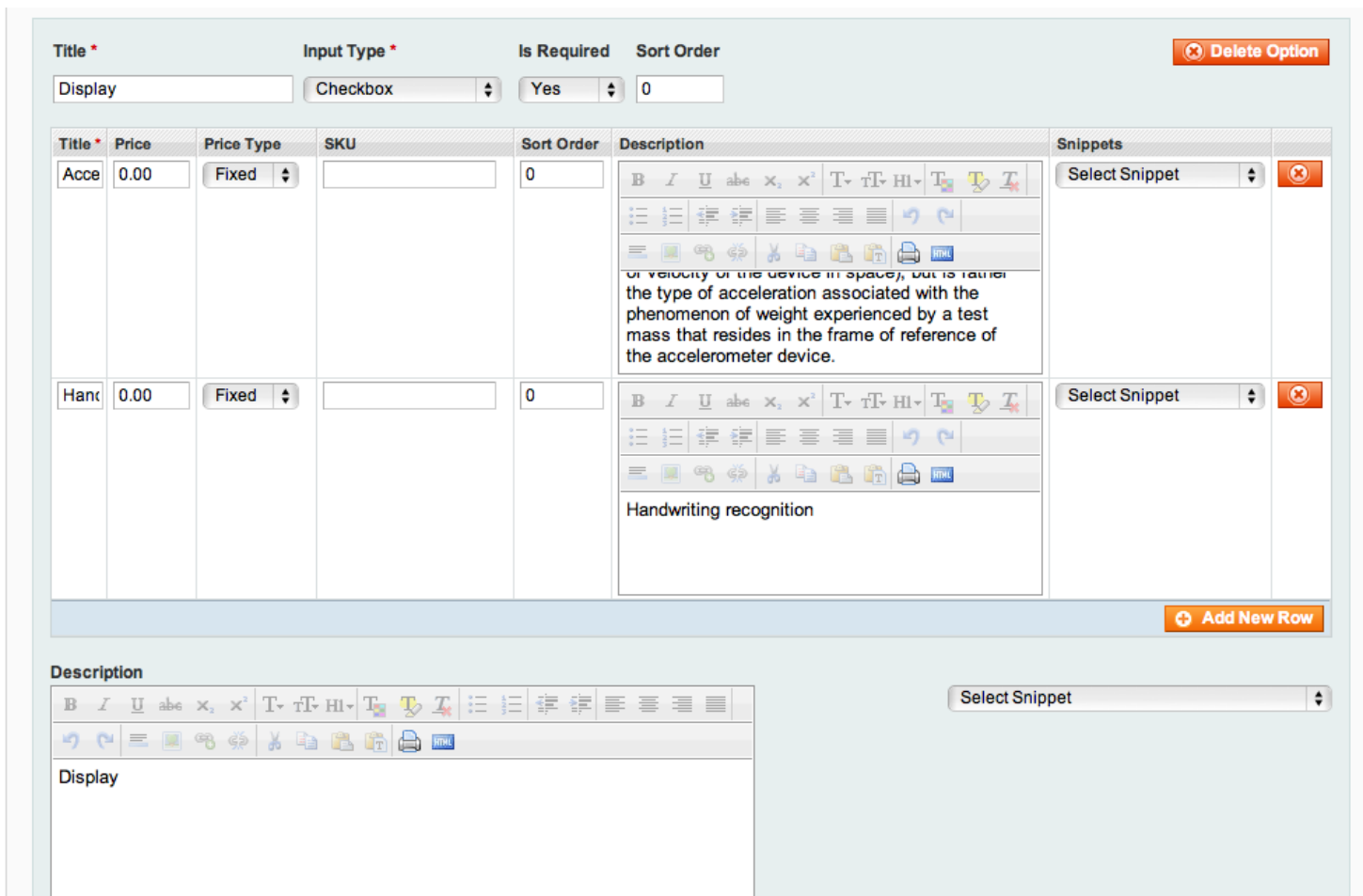

4. Attribute Description for Custom Options

You may even add descriptions for custom options. In order to do that:


- Go to *Catalog*→*Manage Products*.
- Select the desired product from the list.
- Now on the Product Information page select Custom Options tab. There you will find Description field were you will want to add your content (see the screenshot below).
- It is possible to add descriptions both for custom options title, and for custom options themselves.



On the screenshot above besides new 'Description' fields, you can also see 'Snippets' dropdown controls.

With these snippets you can add a description from a template. This is very useful when you have a lot of products that have similar custom options with similar meanings. How to create those snippet templates you can read below.

On the product page custom option description will look like as follows:

5. **Creating and Using Custom Options Snippets**

In the 4-th section we mentioned Snippets. They are used as templates for custom options titles and for custom options themselves. To add/edit those snippets in Admin Panel go to *Catalog->Custom Options Snippets*.

After a snippet is created, it will be possible to add it to any custom options description for any product. Snippet's name will appear in the 'Snippets' dropdown from the screenshot above.
