Ropes on Roofs & Fall Protection Competent Person Training Course

Invest in YOUR future & safety with the 2-day Ropes on Roofs & Fall Protection Competent Person course. In this class we will teach you how to set up a fall protection system before your feet leave the ground so you can safely access roofs from the beginning to the end of the job. Topics include:

Introduction to Fall Protection Fall Protection equipment All About Rope Knots Webbing & Carabiners Line Placement Methods Anchoring – Single & Load Sharing Anchors Working on Pitched Roofs Suspension Trauma, Self Rescue & Assisted Rescue Fall Protection Hazard Survey OSHA Fall Protection Requirements & Fall Protection program Gear Inspection & Maintenance

This is a hands-on class and each participant will be issued a harness with all needed components and a climbing helmet (for use in class). Class size limited to 12 students to insure maximum safety and student participation. For a class at your facility we need a classroom area with display (TV or projector), an area where we can hang a rope for each student to experience the harness (a warehouse with 12 – 20 foot ceiling usually works well), and ideally an easy roof (under 6/12 pitch) for Day 1 and a steeper roof (greater than 6/12) for Day 2. This is an ideal setup but we can discuss other arrangements if necessary.
