Honey Hole Reed

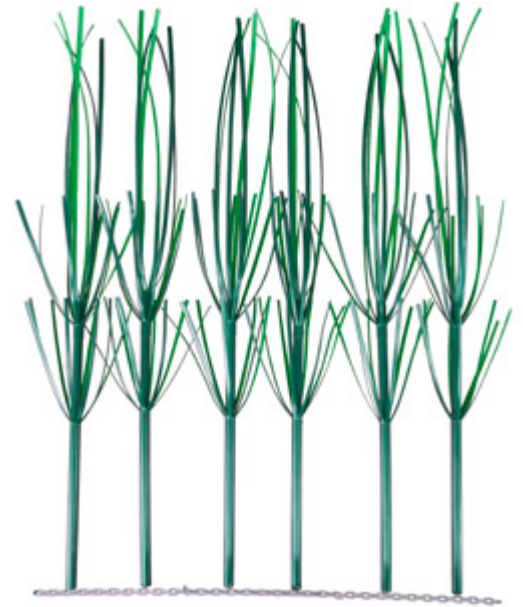
RECOMMENDED PLACEMENT

Honey Hole® Reeds were first implemented as highly fish-able substitutes to flooded riparian vegetation like rushes, reeds, and cattails. Fisheries biologists recognize that while flooded vegetation provides excellent cover for a variety of fish species, it is often seasonal and intermittent. However, deploying Honey Hole® Reeds provides a permanent solution to this ideal habitat type and is easier to fish through than any natural type. Reeds are meant to be placed in water between eight to ten feet deep.

Assembly Instructions

Honey Hole® Reed requires no assembly. However, for your convenience, two stainless quick links are provided to join three Reed segments together to create a large line of habitat.

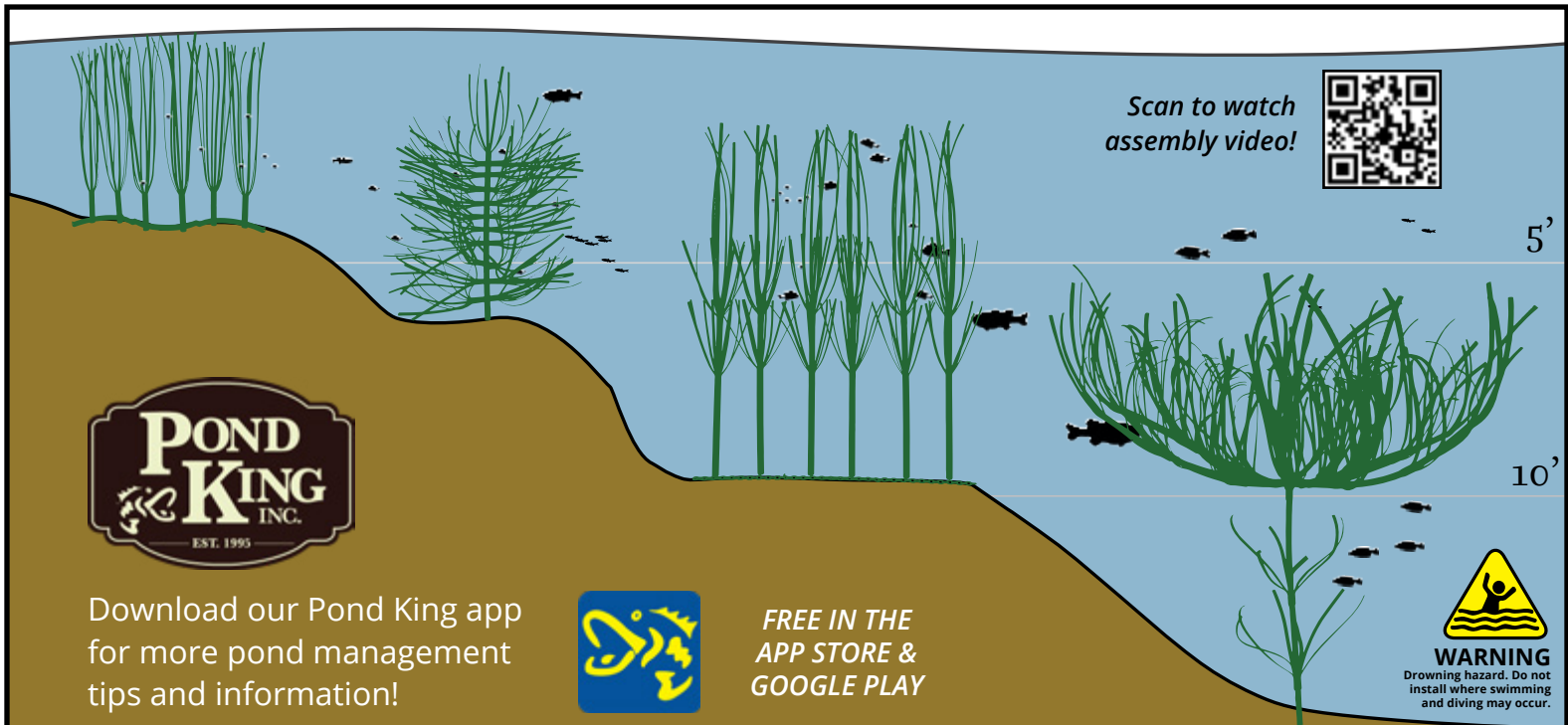
- To assemble, simply link the galvanized chain together with the quick links.
- To maximize coverage area, spread the leaves apart by folding them backward against each limb.
- Honey Hole Reeds were designed to self-right during deployment. Simply toss it in and watch it sink.



Package Contents

- (6) Honey Hole Reeds
(3 sets of 2 stems each)
- (2) Stainless Quick Connects
- (3) 2' Segments of 1/4" Galvanized Chain

It is recommended that you wear safety glasses when shaping and installing the Honey Hole Live Series products.
