Specie:	Red Oak Veneer

Cutting Methods:	Quartered or plain slicing	
Uses:	Used in all wood sectors due to its resistance to external agents. Used for the production of furniture, doors, panels, wood floors and stairs. In the United States, it is widely used for whiskey barrels.	
Characteristics:	Given that there are more than 80 species of Oak in the US alone, the color of the heartwood can vary from light to very dark brown. The sapwood, which is not always clearly differentiated from the heartwood, is slightly colored.	
Drying:		e very long since it must be dried using moderate heat revent the wood from splitting.
Surface:	All treatments can be done without difficulty. Often used for rustic tints.	
Gluing:	It glues well but nail joints require pre-drilling.
