


# rockymounts **Drop** Top




## Guidelines

- Maximum weight: 35lbs (16kgs) per bike
- Compatible with 12mm & 15mm thru axles (up to 110mm wide) only; quick release forks can be mounted with 9mm dummy axle (sold separately)
- Not for use with tandem bicycles
- After loading a bicycle, shake fork side to side to ensure assembly is tight and secure

#### Parts Included


A: DropTop Body D: M6 Flat Washer G: Key
B: T30 Torx Key E: Track Plate
C: M6 x 30 SHCS Torx Bolt F:Lock Core



## 1 Install Body


## For Hard Mounting

Using body as a template, mark locations and drill holes on mounting surface (Holes for M6 or 1/4" hardware and are spaced at 110mm for both mounting orientations). Install mount onto surface using appropriate fasteners.



#### For Track Mounting


Loosely install the included M6 x 30 Torx Bolt (utilizing either the vertical or horizontal mounting holes depending on orientation of mount) with a Flat Washer and a Track Plate onto the mount. Slide the mount along with the track hardware into desired position and tighten both bolts with the T30 Torx Key.



#### Assembly Instructions Cont.


## 2 Install Lock Core

Insert key into core. Line up the protruding retaining wafer between the indicator tabs on the handle and insert lock core.




## 3 Load Bicycle

Remove front wheel and reinstall axle. Open DropTop, load axle into clamp and close the top cap. Rotate T-bolt into place and close




## 4 Adjusting T-Bolt

Handle should close with some force. If too tight or too loose, open handle and adjust T-holt until handle closes with desired tension



## 5 Secure Bicycle

After bicycle is securely mounted, insert key and turn to lock handle. Shake fork side to side to ensure secure mounting.



## Warnings

- •Remove baby seats, panniers, U-locks, or items that could detach from the bicycle
- •Check all fasteners before each use and periodically lubricate T-bolt
- •If mounted externally, remove bicycles before entering car wash
- •Once a year, remove from car to clean and inspect for damage or rusting
