The templates below are mere suggestions. Please feel free to adapt to your age or be creative and invent your own way of writing to your friend. You can use just one or several. The idea is to pick the templates which speak to you.

TEMPLATES

My Christmas portrait

The aim of the Christmas portrait is to describe your way of celebrating in a creative manner. It can be filled in with words or pictures. You can of course adapt and send pictures of your Christmas traditions too. Burlington made an example for you.

This template is intended for those celebrating Christmas as the birth of baby Jesus. Fill in with words/photos or drawings.

Burlington made an example for you.


CHRISTMAS CARD

 - 5 Send your presentation by email to your pen pal or by post
