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SERPENT SEED

To thoroughly understand Satan's plans to reign in Jesus's image at the end of the age, it is imperative to grasp how this all began. In doing so, it ensures you can better understand Revelation's signs, symbols, dates and events by discerning the truth recorded in Genesis. The book of Revelation is a direct parallel to the book of Genesis. It has all been carefully planned by our Creator from beginning to end.

Remember the former things of old: for I am God, and there is none else; I am God, and there is none like me, Declaring the end from the beginning, and from ancient times the things that are not yet done, saying, My counsel shall stand, and I will do all my pleasure: Calling a ravenous bird from the east, the man that executeth my counsel from a far country: yea, I have spoken it, I will also bring it to pass; I have purposed it, I will also do it. Hearken unto me, ye stouthearted, that are far from righteousness: I bring near my righteousness; it shall not be far off, and my salvation shall not tarry: and I will place salvation in Zion for Israel my glory.

Isaiah 46:9–13

God alone is the Alpha and Omega, the beginning and end. He has established what will be and is very aware of Satan's role at the end of the age. Notice Isaiah says God calls a ravenous bird, a man filled with Satan, to bring God's will to pass. The Creator is going to restore paradise by destroying all evil using evil. *Ravenous* means "voracious, gluttonous, and rapacious," which is an excessively greedy appetite for inappropriate behavior. A raven's black color

without any bright feathers does not indicate a black race but is used here to suggest a symbolic meaning of darkness, wickedness and evil much like the Black Madonna Cult mentioned earlier in the *BEGUILED* Series. In fact, in the beginning God separated his pure light from the darkness—good from evil before he ever created the sun, moon, and stars. So, God’s symbol of a raven is very interesting as ravens throughout history have long been considered birds of ill omen and death. They are clumsy agricultural pests and extremely quarrelsome with other birds. Ravens enjoy feeding on carcass as well as preying on small weaker animals.

A raven has no music in his sharp squawking voice and no sweet song like other birds. He makes a mocking noise reminiscent of how Scripture defines Satan. Ravens make distinctive deep noises with resonating *prruk-prruk-prruk* calls, high-knocking *toc-toc-toc* sounds, dry and grating *kraa* calls as well as low guttural rattles. Their noises produce an unharmonious resonance that is very irritating to listen to. They can even mimic sounds from their environment, including human speech. In fact, ravens actually have a unique cognitive ability to manipulate other birds into doing work for them. They are known to steal and are infatuated with extremely shiny objects. What a perfect description of Satan because he is God’s greatest pest, a mimicker, a stealer, preys on the feeble, and brings death while portraying himself as luminous. These traits are being brought out in Scripture to help humanity understand Satan is like a raven. God created both the raven and Satan. He will use Satan to do what is necessary to bring an end to Satan’s own evil at the end of the age.

It is important to remember Noah’s actions in Genesis 8:7, that says before he sent the dove he, “sent forth a raven, which went forth to and fro, until the waters were dried up from off the earth.” This is all a parallel to explain that before earth was inhabitable, in the beginning, God had already created Satan and released him to also go to and fro. And, just like Noah’s raven, Satan did not and will not ever come back to God. The dove on the other hand that Noah released after the raven is symbolic of Jesus because it returns to Noah bringing an olive leaf, the return of planet Earth to truth and the promise of eternal life. Jesus came into the world to save the lost from Satan’s wickedness that Satan as the serpent first planted in God’s *pure* garden of Eden. It is through Jesus and only Jesus, God’s *pure* olive tree, that all mankind can now receive eternal life.

But some of these branches from Abraham's tree—some of the people of Israel— have been broken off. And you Gentiles, who were branches from a wild olive tree, have been grafted in. So now you also receive the blessing God has promised Abraham and his children, sharing in the rich nourishment from the root of God's special olive tree.

Romans 11:17, *New Living Translation*

What really did happen in the beginning that was so bad our Creator had to send his only Son to die on the cross of Calvary, that we might have everlasting life and not eternal damnation? These strange circumstances surrounding mankind's beginning should not be overlooked. There is a lot more information in Genesis than most people want to accept, but if you want to know the truth, you have to be willing to acknowledge the whole truth. Mankind's fall from eternal bliss in Eden had a lot more to do with the serpent than just Adam and Eve eating a piece of fruit.

The First Humans Created Outside the Garden

The male and female created by God in Genesis chapter 1 were told to “multiply and replenish Earth.” The word *replenish* is a very strange word for God to use concerning a world that seems to have just been created since it means to “restock” or “resupply”. If this is true, then something had come prior that brought great destruction. God seems to be having to reconstruct and repopulate what something or someone else had destroyed from that he had initially created. Notice everything God does in Genesis states it is for good except when darkness is mentioned. Genesis specifically says God divided the light from the darkness and called only the light good. In fact, every living being he creates is also called good and are all given fruit, herbs, and seeds to eat. There is no indication any animal was eating meat, which clearly explains nothing with blood was dying. Everything was also commissioned to bring forth after their kind through seed within them, including plants and trees. In the beginning, God created animals before he created a male and female in his image. This particular male and female were given dominion over all other creatures on earth, so these first pre-humans were not in the garden of Eden, but roaming earth with other animals.
