


The War in Heaven and the Firmament

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WHAT you're looking at is the world we live in according to Scripture. That arch in the sky isn't a rainbow, neither. If it were, it would have seven colors though. We call it the firmament, and it's a solid structure. You were probably hoping I'd say space. Deep space. Proof that what I'm showing you is wrong is the fact that you watched an astronaut on TV once. Must not have seen the bubbles. You will tell me it was an ISS astronaut preforming acrobatics against a green screen in zero gravity. Must not have seen the wires then. And I know what you're probably already thinking. N_0 , the firmament is not poetry. Even if it were though, you can't just start spitting out rapping rhymes whenever you want to make twaddle up. That's not how the Bible works. Here, I'll give you an example.

Its Hebrew counterpart is *rāqîa'* (בְּלִיעֵ). That's raw-kee'-ah, as phonetic spellings go. *Strong's 7549*—for all the fact checkers out there. Its definition is as follows.

And on the second day he created the *expanse* [rāqîa' דָּלִיעַ in the midst of the waters, and the waters were divided on that day half of them went up above and half of them went down below the *expanse* [rāqîa' דְּלִיעַ] that was in the midst

expanse [rāqîa' לָרָלִיעְ] from the waters which were above the expanse [rāqîa' לָרָלִיעְ]: and it was so.

8 And Elohiym called the expanse [rāqîa' לָרָלִיעְ Heaven. And the evening and the morning were the second day.

Bere'Shiyth (Genesis) 1:6-8 [Cepher] over the face of the whole earth. And this was the only work Elohiym created on the second day.

Yovheliym (Jubilees) 2:4 [Cepher]

- ¹⁶ By the multitude of your merchandise they have filled the midst of you with violence, and you have sinned: therefore, I will cast you as profane out of the mountain of Elohiym: and I will destroy you, O covering Keruv, from the midst of the stones of fire.
- ¹⁷ Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty, you have corrupted your wisdom by reason of your brightness: I will cast you to the ground, I will lay you before kings, that they may behold you.
- ¹⁸ You have defiled your sanctuaries by the multitude of your iniquities, by the iniquity of your traffic; therefore, will I bring forth a fire from the midst of you, it shall devour you, and I will bring you to ashes upon the earth in the sight of all them that behold you.
- ¹⁹ All they that know you among the people shall be astonished at you: you shall be a terror, and never shall you be anymore.

Yechezq'el (Ezekiel) 28: 13-17 [Cepher]

Best to keep him out of heaven then. Or as Yahusha HaMashiach so eloquently put it:

And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven.
