Gaia Herbs Receives Gold Medal for Inc.'s Inaugural Best in Business Awards in Wellness Products Category

Additionally, Gaia Herbs donated 220 gallons and 1,500 individual two-ounce spray bottles of hand sanitizers to local organizations and first responders of the pandemic, as well as 13,500 two-ounce bottles to every K-12 student in the Henderson County Public Schools district. Gaia Herbs also held two socially-distanced volunteer days for its employees to help assemble the back-to-school hygiene kits that included the donated hand sanitizer along with face masks and educational health information to help keep the local students and teachers safe. Gaia Herbs was selected from a very competitive applicant pool, with around 2,700 total entries and an acceptance rate in the low single digits.
