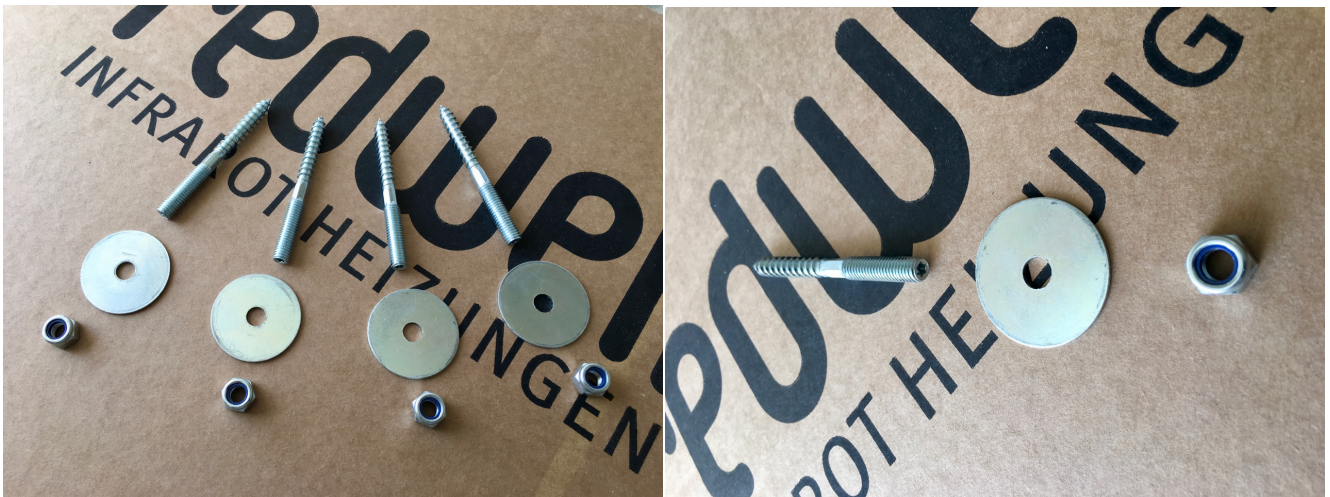


Suitable Ceiling Installation Method – GUIDANCE ONLY

The installation of an infrared heating element should be completed by a qualified and/or competent person only. The standard fixing materials provided are **NOT** suitable for ceiling installation or plasterboard walls. It is the responsibility of the installer to ensure the fixing materials used are adequate.

Below outlines suitable fixings and a safe method of fixing Redwell Infrared Heating Panels to the ceiling. Please note this is for guidance only and full responsibility lies with the installing technician.

FIXINGS



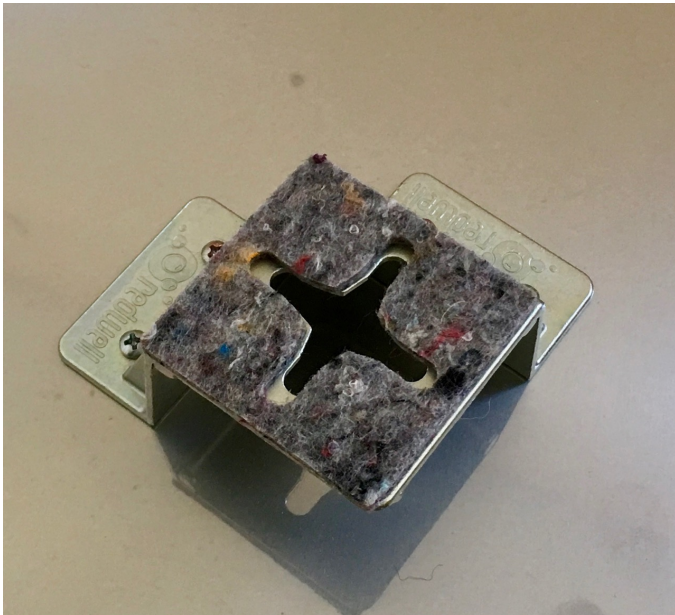
M8 Dowel Screws : **M8 Mudguard Washers** : **M8 Nyloc Nuts**

It is imperative the fixings suspending the Redwell Heating panel are fixed securely to timber battens or a pattern pre-installed behind the plasterboard ceiling. **DO NOT FIX TO PLASTERBOARD ONLY.**



Fix dowel screws through plasterboard ceiling into suitable pre-installed timbers leaving approximately 25mm of M8 thread protruding to accept M8 Mudguard Washers and Nyloc Nuts





Ensure the self adhesive pads are installed to the brackets on the rear of the heating panels as indicated opposite



It is advised to use a minimum of 2 persons to lift the heating panel and present it over the pre-installed M8 fixings.

An adjustable extension support prop as indicated opposite and below may be used to hold the heating panel in place until fixings are secured.





Install M8 Mudguard Washers and M8 Nyloc Nuts to each threaded dowel screw and tighten to very slightly compress the pre-installed self-adhesive pads. Once all fixings are secured remove support.
