

# Mary's Command to Catholics

In the Gospel of St John, we read of the marriage feast at Cana. Here Mary emphasizes the importance of Jesus and the words that He says. Realising that the wine was gone and that she herself could not do anything, Mary tells Jesus, because He is the only One who could do something. Mary then gives the stewards a command, one that we must consider for us to be saved. Mary said, **“Whatever He say to you, do it!”**

These are **the last recorded words of Mary**, and the only passage in the Bible where Mary gives a command. It is therefore important for everyone, including for all Roman Catholics, to take heed to the words, **“Whatever He says to you, do it!”** Since the goal of all good Catholics is to get to heaven, let us look in the Bible and do what Mary said to do – read what Jesus says and do it.

Jesus says He is the only one that can save and be our saviour. **“I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me,”**(John 14:6).



The Bible also says that Jesus is the only Mediator between God and man (1 Timothy 2:5), and it is only through Him that we have access to God the Father, (Ephesians 2:18).

Jesus never said to trust in saints, the sacraments, the Pope or Mary to save us. The Bible

says **“Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men (than Jesus) by which we must be saved,”** (Acts 4:12).



This picture is a false representation of Mary by a Catholic artist. She never had rosary beads - they are a Hindu invention, also later adopted by Buddhism, Islam, & later by Catholics.

Only Jesus can save us! Jesus never said for us to make special sacrifices or do good works in order to be saved. He did say **“But to him who does not work but believes on Him who justifies the ungodly, his faith is accounted as righteousness,”** (Romans 4:5).

**“For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith – and this not from ourselves, it is the gift of God – not by works, lest anyone should boast,”** (Ephesians 2:8-9).

And: **“That if you confess with your mouth, “Jesus is Lord,” and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved,”** (Romans 10:9-10).

Jesus says that God's words are the only authority to follow: **“He that rejects me, and receives not my words, has one that judges him: the word that I have spoken, the same shall judge him in the last day.”** (John 12:48).

Jesus did not say that traditions or the rules of men could be added to His words. Instead He said, **“They worship Me in vain; their teachings are but rules taught by men. You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to the traditions of men... You have a fine way of setting aside the commands of God in order to observe your own traditions! ...Thus you nullify the word of God by your tradition that you have handed down. And you do many things like that,”** (Mark 7:7-9, 13).

It must be pointed out that the Bible, God’s Word, clearly curses anyone who adds to or takes away from the Word of God - the Holy Bible, (See Revelation 22:18; John 10:35; Deuteronomy 4:2 & 12:32; & Proverbs 30:5-6). This means that God has cursed the Roman Catholic Church because they have adopted doctrine and practise that He opposes. This includes the idolization of Mary, instead of simply obeying this one command she made in real life!

You can know that you are saved and have eternal life if you put your complete faith in Jesus Christ, and stop relying on yourself, the church, the sacraments or any other works. Jesus is the only way to heaven. Jesus said, **“I write these things to you who believe in the name of the Son of God so that you may know that you have eternal life,”** (1 John 5:13).

Did you read that carefully? You can KNOW that you have eternal life, but only through your acceptance of Jesus, based on His terms. This has nothing to do with Mary.






Pope Francis with the idol of the Queen of Heaven








