


Please make sure the system toggle on the top left corner has been switched to the same system as your computer's operating system.






2 The VIA Key Remapping Software



6 Adjust The Backlight Brightness




8 Warranty

10 Factory Reset



Troubleshooting? Don't know what's going on with the keyboard?

- 1) Try factory reset by pressing fn1 + J + Z (for 4 seconds).
- 2 Download the right firmware for your keyboard from our website.
- Remove the power cable from the keyboard. (3) Remove the space bar keycap to find the reset button on the PCB.
- 4 Hold the reset key while plugging in the power cable and then release the reset key. The keyboard now will enter DFU mode.
- (5) Flash the firmware with the QMK Toolbox.
- 6 Factory reset the keyboard again by pressing fn1 + J + Z (for 4 seconds).
