



10Litre Wax Melter

Congratulations on upping your wax production with our 10 Litre Wax Melter with Temperature Control.

Before getting started please read the following lists of Do's and Don'ts as this is a piece of machinery and as such must be treated with care and be operated within the following recommendations.

We thank you for your custom and hope to see you again! Enjoy!

1. Prior to adding wax or turning on the machine check that the tap is operational and can fully open and close with ease. If the tap has seized contact us for advice.
2. Ensure the tap is set fully to the closed position before adding your solid wax
3. Set the temperature to the melting temperature as recommended by your wax supplier (this is often around 75 degrees Celsius). Do NOT set the temperature higher in an effort to speed up the melting process as this can overheat pockets of your wax potentially causing it to smoke and/or discolor.
4. The external walls and tap can get HOT so please use heat proof gloves when operating this machine
5. Never leave the Simply Scented Wax Melter on without you being present and attentive.
6. If using an extension lead ensure that it is fully uncoiled.
7. Do NOT mix fragrance oil, dyes or additives directly in the wax melter. Decant into separate vessel first.
8. On occasion you may find you tap clogged with soft wax when you open it. should this happen use a skewer stick or similar to push the clog aside to allow the liquid wax to flow. Make sure you have your decanting vessel ready under the tap when you do as the wax will flow freely immediately.
9. Please make sure you turn your Simply Scented Wax Melter off at both the machine and the plug after use.
10. The wax temperature may rise slightly above the set temperature on the vessel. Use a secondary thermometer (we recommend infrared) to ensure your wax is at your desired temperature.
11. The wax melter shall always be used with RCD protection.
