


The pending work is Painting, doors, roof, and donor name installation.

Covid 19 Lockdown - Brief Info

On 24 March 2020, the Government of India ordered a nationwide lockdown for 21 days. On 14 April, the nationwide lockdown extended until 3 May, with a conditional relaxations after 20 April for the regions where the spread had been contained or was minimal.

On 1 May, the Government of India extended the nationwide lockdown further by two weeks until 17 May. The Government divided all the districts into three zones based on the spread of the virus—green, red and orange—with relaxations applied accordingly. On 17 May, the lockdown was further extended till 31 May by the National Disaster Management Authority.

On May 30th, it was announced that the ongoing lockdown would be further extended till 30th June in containment zones, with services resuming in a phased manner starting from 8th June.

Red Zones: There is a restriction on all activities in these areas.

Orange Zones: Limited transport and restricted services and activities.

Green Zones: All activities except those prohibited nationwide will be allowed.

Within Red Zones and Orange Zones, district authorities will identify clusters (colonies/wards/towns in urban centres and villages/panchayats/blocks in rural areas) as containment zones where life will be severely restricted..

Note: Sikar District of Rajasthan is placed under Orange zone with few of our schools selected for construction have been declared as containment zone. Work can be resumed by Mid June, according to the district authorities.

Project completion schedule

Challenges post Lockdown:

- 1. Shortage of Workers (Migrant workers have moved back to their natives across India)
- 2. Situations can change anytime due to covid 19 and permission to resume work can be withdrawn.

Planned activities:

- 1. Our Local co-ordinators are well connected with District authorities and will be working towards the completion of the project with all the resources available to them in the current situation.
- 2. The current Vendor will finish the remaing work of Phase1 as soon as the restrictions are lifted.
- 3. In Parallel, another vendor will be hired to initaite phase 2 so, we can finish the project as scheduled.
