I. Self Defence project - Uttar Pradesh

Area of work: Lucknow-Gorakhpur

'Self-Defense for Women & Gender' and 'Sensitization for Boys'

we have successfully finished Self defence Camp at Gorakhpur.

We conducted 4 camps and Rajkiya Kanya Inter College Sardar Nagar District District Gorakhpur covered 215 girls in these 4 camps.

We recovered approximately 54 girls in each camp. Self defense training is a 3 day course. Every day 4 hours of training provided by trained trainers in these camps.

Self defense training course is divided into two parts one part is theoretical and one part is practical.

The participants learnt about the laws, helpline numbers, how to approach the Police station etc in the theoretical section.

They learnt the various techniques of Self defence back kick front kick and how to use self defence weapons like Shakti weapon, ring, sticks etc in their practical section.

After attending our 3 days Self defence training camp girls are so confident to tackle any kind of dangerous situation. They were excited to learn more things too. They convey these skills to their friends, relatives and siblings too.

We have partnered with SRI RAM CHARITABLE TRUST for conducting these camps.

II. Orcale Livelihood project

Area of work: Karnataka

We are running four different programs mentioned as follows:

- 2) *Free tailoring classes for women & girls.*
- 3) *Hand wash station installation.*
- 4) *Menstrual hygiene awareness campaign.*

*** Free Computer and english training classes.**

We are coaching basic computer hardwares and softwares,MS applications,Trouble shooting.,etc to the students.

English will cover greetings,handling job live situations,debates etc.,

We currently have 20 students in february batch.

*** Free Tailoring course for women and girls.**

We are conducting free tailoring course for the women and girls .

We have multiple training centers spread across bengaluru in karnataka. We are teaching both basic and advanced course of tailoring to the beneficiaries.

These training centers will be conducted till march 2021. Currently we training 101 women across different locations.

* Menstrual hygiene awareness program

We are conducting menstrual hygiene awareness camps at schools and communities to help them understand the importance of menstrual hygiene.

We have prepared a video which explains about the menstrual cycles.

During this time we also distribute free reusable cloth sanitary napkins for free .
