- Government schools: Bio-toilets built in Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, Uttar Pradesh
 Arunachal Pradesh, Maharashtra and West Bengal,
 benefiting 33,998 school children.
- Rural India: Bio-toilets built in schools and villages across Karnataka, Tamil Nadu, and Uttar Pradesh, benefiting 4,707 families.
- 3. **Government-guaranteed permanent land dwelling slums:** Portable toilets built in Karnataka, benefiting **3,220** families.
