I. ASSESSMENT PHASE

Area of work: Mirzapur, Uttar Pradesh

We initiated our project in Uttar Pradesh in the year 2016. Since then, we have built 140+ toilets in four Districts of Uttar Pradesh - Mirzapur, Varanasi, Agra, and Lucknow. We have felt a significant change in the communities where we have built toilets over the past two years. The number of enrolment in schools has increased, the percentage of communicable diseases has reduced, we can observe a healthy and hygienic environment in the villages and much more.

This year, we have identified 14 new schools/colleges in need of sanitation facilities. (See Table 1) The schools/colleges are selected based on the Sewa criteria for identification of schools. In the second week of March, our team visited the schools to conduct the need analysis. (See Figure 1)

Area of work: Shimoga, Karnataka

We thank Sewa Phoenix chapter, for conducting *Hike for Hygiene* fundraising event and the generous donation towards building toilets in India. We have identified a government school/college in Hosanagar Taluk, Shimoga District of Karnataka to build toilets. (See Figure 2)

Our Sewa team conducted the need analysis and have identified the need of four toilets. (See Table 2)

Area of work: Miraj, Maharashtra

In our February monthly report, we had provided details of Repair and renovation work in Miraj, Maharashtra. (See Table 3) The installation work was initiated in the last week of February, we have replaced the broken doors, the leaking roofs, and other minor repairs were completed.(See Figure 3)

III. Post Installation Maintenance Phase, Inauguration of Bio-toilets

Area of work: GGHSS Sanarpatty - Dindigul, Tamil Nadu

Sewa team received a request letter from the president of Parents teachers association of GGHSS for additional toilets. After the need analysis, Sewa team felt that the existing 18 toilets were insufficient for 1,087 girls. Parents, teachers, and students of GGHSS are thankful to the Sewa donors for understanding their needs and providing sanitation facilities. (See Figure 4)

Area of work: Chunar, Uttar Pradesh

In second phase of bio-toilets installation in Chunar, we have built 10 toilets in schools/colleges of Mirzapur District, Uttar Pradesh. Sewa team inaugurated the bio-toilets in third week of March. Students thanked the Sewa donors and the executing team for the quick response and for providing them the basic sanitation facilities. (See Figure 5)

IV. Health and Hygiene

Area of work: Uttarakhand and Uttar Pradesh

Celebrating international women's day has become more and more special as the society at large recognizes women achievers in various fields; such as this year's women's day celebrations in Uttarakhand by Sewa International Bharat.

On this occasion, Sewa Toilet and Hygiene for girl child's team launched the swachatha project with eco-friendly menstrual hygiene awareness camps in villages in Karnaprayag, Gochar, Rudhraprayag, and adjacent communities.

We also launched this initiative in Kashi at various schools, Vaishnavi convent in Chunar, government school at the Naxalite area of Chunar in the Mirzapur districts, Ram Nagar just to name a few. We have launched this initiative in 14 different areas and distributed samples to young girls who wanted to be part of our program. (See Figure 6)
