## **New Sewa Toilet repair work at Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh**

Sewa is continuously constructing new toilets and repairing non-functional toilets in many government schools and slum areas in Uttar Pradesh since last 3 years. We initiated our project in Uttar Pradesh in the year 2016. Since then, we have built over 140+ toilets in four Districts of Uttar Pradesh - Mirzapur, Varanasi, Agra, and Lucknow. From our need analysis data, we realized more than 45% of the government schools do not have functional toilet units and 50% of these schools do not have water connection. From 2018, we started focusing on repair and renovation of these existing non-functional toilets. We have felt a significant change in the communities where we have built toilets over the past two years. The number of enrolment in schools has increased, the percentage of communicable diseases has reduced, and we can observe a healthy and hygienic environment in the villages and much more.

In continuity of toilet repair work now we are going to start work in government schools of Lucknow very soon. **A very kind hearted and little girl is raising the fund. She is just 13 doing fantastic job in this young age. She is RIYA DADHEECH, a true inspiration and icon of youngsters.**

## **New Sewa Toilets Construction in North East-Arunachal Pradesh**

- All Arunachal Pradesh Students' Union (AAPSU) conducted a survey which lighted the poor infrastructure in government schools in August 2018. According to the survey, 53 percent schools in Arunachal Pradesh do not have drinking water supply, only 20 percent have library and laboratory, 40 percent do not have sanitation facilities (adolescent girls and female teaching staff suffer the most). The average number of toilets in government schools is 2.
- Most of the students come from humble agricultural background families. They get water supply for one hour every day and they do not have any water storage facility. Again credit goes to Bay area chapter, who has raised the funds for this project.
