## I. Bio-toilet inauguration - Mysore, Karnataka

### Area of work: KR Nagar

Hippocampus Learning Centres (HLC) are transforming the lives of underserved children through high-quality education. Hippocampus started in 2011 and has experienced rapid growth since. It currently operates more than 225 preschool centers and 7 primary schools. Its programs are also licensed to more than 70 schools in Karnataka and Maharashtra.

We received a request letter from the Mysore campus a few months ago. Sewa conducted the need analysis and decided to build 6 toilet units. (See Figure 1)

The bio-toilet installation work was completed in the third week of September. It'll be benefitting 160 children from poor economic background families who are getting sponsored and supported at Supreet Educational and health trust through various individual donors of the school. (*Refer Table 1*)

## II. Bio-toilet installation - Kolar, Karnataka

#### Area of work: Kolar

In our August newsletter, we had provided the details of the Sai Samyuktha Primary school situated in Kolar District of Karnataka. We have built 8 Bio-toilet units which will be benefiting 350 children from low economic background families. (Refer Table 2)

The construction work was completed in the last week of September. The toilets will be inaugurated on Oct 2nd which is Mahatma Gandhi Ji's 150th Birthday. (See Figure 2)
