I. Need Analysis

Area of work: Miraj, Maharashtra

Our sewa volunteers conducted the need analysis at Urdu primary school, Miraj. The school is located in Sangli district of Maharashtra. (See figure 1) This sanitation project will be benefitting 183 students and 7 teachers. (See table 1) We will be restoring 8 toilet units and 1 boys urinals under Repair and Renovation phase I, Miraj. (See table 2)
