IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Kindly complete the enrolment form before booking a slot. Our classes maintain a small size, with a maximum of 12 students per lesson.

Both primary and high school students will follow the same curriculum, but high school students will receive advanced instruction. If your child is gifted and finds the primary class too easy, they can switch to the high school class.

Payment for the entire term is required upfront, covering all art materials for each lesson and a take-home painting kit for every student.

Our teacher is a qualified artist with a working with children check and over 5 years of experience as an art teacher.

If your child needs extra assistance, you are welcome to stay during the class. All children must be signed in/out, dropped off and picked up by an adult.

Currently, we do not provide makeup classes, but this policy may change in the future.

Parking - We do have small car park out the back of the studio or we recommend parking at Coles and walking up, approx. 3 min walk.

WEEK 1 – INTRO TO ACRYLIC

Date: Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday

Time: 4pm - 5pm or 5:30pm - 7pm

Location: 128 Princes Highway Fairy Meadow

Dive into the colourful world of acrylic paint - the rockstar of the painting kingdom! Learn about its speedy drying skills and layering magic.

- What's in Store:
 - Identify and familiarise with various tools such as paintbrushes, palette knives, and palettes.
 - Master the art of brushstrokes, blending, and layering.
 - Roll up your sleeves and dive into hands-on fun with acrylics to unleash your inner artist!

Bonus: Take home your very own brush set, paints, and a booklet to keep the creative vibes flowing at home.



WEEK 2 – COLOUR THEORY

Date: Tuesday, Wednesday or Thursday

Time: 4pm - 5pm or 5:30pm - 7pm

Location: 128 Princes Highway Fairy Meadow

Explore the exciting principles of colour theory, including the colour wheel, primary, secondary, and tertiary colours, complementary colours, and colour harmonies.

- What's in Store:
 - Understand the fundamentals of colour mixing and how to create a wide range of hues, shades, and tints using primary colours.
 - Identify and apply different colour schemes in painting compositions to create visual interest and balance.
 - Experiment with colour combinations and understand how they evoke different moods and emotions in artworks.



WEEK 3 – SUNSET BLEND

- What's in Store:

 - Understand the use of warm and cool colours in sunset compositions to convey mood and ambiance.
 - Practice observational skills by studying reference images of sunsets and translating them onto canvas with acrylic paints.



WEEK 4 – PLANTS & FLORALS

WEEK 7 – PORTRAITURE
