- Blanchon Parquet Joint is an acrylic mastic designed for joints in wooden floors and wood, laminated and melamine floors, filling cracks, fissures and joints between wooden floors and skirting boards.
- Silicone free, Parquet Joint may be lacquered or painted after full polymerization.

SURFACE PREPARATION

- The wood should be sound, clean, dry, free of any traces of existing varnishes, mastics, paints, oils and greases or resins (sand down or strip as necessary with Blanchon Chrono™ Paint Stripper or Blanchon Building Paint Stripper).
- Degrease exotic or resinous wood, if necessary, with an appropriate thinner or acetone.
 Contaminated wood should be scraped, cleaned and treated with Blanchon Trait'Plus® MU.
- Previously lacquered wooden floors and skirting boards should be clean, dry and free of any traces of adhesive or other coatings that could affect the adhesion of **Parquet Joint** on the substrate.
- Carefully remove all traces of dust.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

- Ready to use.
- Apply at a temperature between 12°C and 30°C and relative humidity below 85% in accordance with the Standards in force (please contact our Export Department for further information on French building rules and specifications). Only use in well ventilated areas. Do not leave plants and aquariums in areas where the product has been applied.
- Maximum gap width: 20 mm. Maximum depth: 5 mm.
- For best results, it is recommended to "push" Parquet Joint rather than "pulling" it.

Cleaning of tools

Clean tools immediately after use with water. Do not empty into drains.

DRYING TIMES

- Touch dry: around 20 minutes.
- Before recoating: 24 hours minimum.

STORAGE

- Store in the original unopened container in a cool, dry place (once open, use quickly and carefully seal the container after use.
- Protect from frost (be careful of storing in vehicles).
