SHAKE WELL! *The mixed product should be agitated prior to and during application.*

Turf Grass, Tees, greens & approaches, lawn, landscape turf and sports turf: Apply at a rate of 2-5 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. During periods of active growth or stress, apply every 14 days to 21 days in a minimum of 1.5 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.

General Landscape and nursery greenhouse plant, application either as foliar or drench: Dilute at a rate of 1-2 ounces per 3 gallons of water. Apply with good coverage to the point of runoff every 14-21 days for best results.

Arbor care: Dilute at a rate of 2-3 ounces per 3 gallons of water. Apply as a soil drench in the fall or during periods of stress.

Lawns (blackout): Apply at a rate of 2-5 ounces per 1,000 sq. ft. During periods of active growth or stress, apply every 14 days to 21 days in a minimum of 1.5 gallons of water per 1,000 sq. ft.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Precaution: **0-0-25 GreeneKick™** is a highly concentrated material. If applying in combination with other materials, a compatibility test is recommended to avoid potential incompatibilities. Some complex concentrated tank mixes could show phytotoxicity when applied in very low water volumes during periods of high heat and humidity. **GreeneKick™** remains in the liquid phase on leaf surfaces for a prolonged period of time and demonstrates spray adjuvant properties.

The **N-Ext GreenNePaK™** is a 4-gallon box set for all turf types that covers **N, P, & K**, for the whole season on up to 4,000 sq. ft.

The **N-Ext GreenNePaK™** Lawn Fertilizer Annual Program package consists of:

1. **18-0-1 GreenePunch™**: 2 treatments at 16 ounces per thousand.
2. **16-21-2 GreenePOP™**: 2 treatments at 16 ounces per thousand.
3. **0-0-25 GreeneKick™**: Up to 5 treatments at 6 ounces per thousand.
4. **7-0-0 GreeNe Effect™**: Up to 5 treatments at 6 ounces per thousand.

The **GreenNePaK™** in conjunction with the **N-Ext™ Bio-Stimulant** pack will have everyone in the neighborhood green with envy. Starting out the season with **GreenePunch™ Lawn Fertilizer**, your lawn will get a beautiful boost in growth and vigor, coupling that application with 6 ounces of **GreeneKick™ Potassium Turf Fertilizer** will start the lawn off right. The next app would consist of both **GreenePOP™** and **GreeneKick™** to keep that green going! As you hit the heat, **GreeNe Effect™** and **GreeneKick™** go to work to reduce stress and add a deep green color. This application can be repeated 4 weeks apart! As we come into the home stretch, we're back on the **GreenePOP™** and **GreenePunch™** for our last applications. The beauty is that the **GreeneKick™** and the **GreeNe Effect™** can be added with each and every app as desired.

COOL SEASON GRASSES (i.e. Bluegrass, Fescues, Ryegrass) are best able to add root mass and store and process nitrogen in the spring and fall when soil temperatures are between 50 and 65 degrees. During the summer months when daytime temperatures are above 85 degrees and overnight temperatures are above 70 degrees, soil temperatures rise which triggers the plant to shed roots and slow its metabolic processes. Extended heat or drought stress can and often does trigger cool season grasses to enter a period of dormancy. It is for these reasons that we recommend reduced applications of nitrogen during the summer months.

For cool season turf grasses, we recommend between 1.4 and 2.2 pounds of nitrogen per 1,000 sq. ft. per growing season (depending on growing zone).

WARM SEASON GRASSES (i.e. Bermuda, Saint Augustine, Zoysia, Centipede) are best able to add root mass and store and process nitrogen in the summer when soil temperatures are above 65 degrees. During the summer months when daytime temperatures are above 85 degrees and overnight temperatures are above 70 degrees, soil temperatures rise which triggers the plant to add roots and facilitate its metabolic processes. Extended drought stress can and often does trigger warm season grasses to enter a period of semi-dormancy. In tropical and sub-tropical zones, warm season grasses typically do not enter a period of dormancy. In transition zones, Bermuda and Saint Augustine will enter a winter dormancy period. It is important to note, that although the turf is winter dormant, the soil is still active.

APPLICATIONS/DILUTION RATE We recommend a 20-1 dilution rate for applications of each of the products in the **GreenNePaK™** (i.e. 20 ounces water for every one ounce of concentrate). This is why for DIY we recommend the use of a **hose end sprayer**. WATERING IN REQUIREMENT If a **hose end sprayer** is used with a setting that allows for a 20-1 dilution with water with the product being applied, there is no need to water the application in. If there is uncertainty about dilution rates or if you applied the product(s) with less than a 20-1 dilution rate, the application(s) should be watered in for 5-10 minutes.

The **N-Ext GreenNePaK™** and the **N-Ext™ Bio-Stimulant** pack are the perfect pair for a complete fertility program for every turf type. Simply follow the instructions for each of the packages and enjoy your lawn... and yes, both packages can be applied on the same day. We do not however, recommend mixing them all together in the same sprayer for a single application.
