

Notes for Creating a Snap Purse

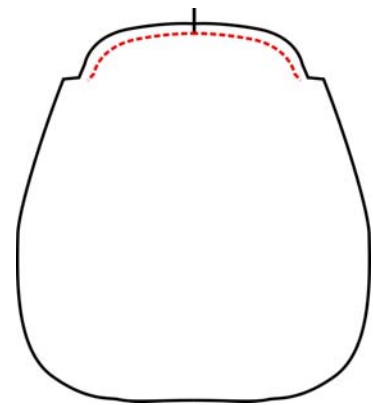


1. Embroider your fabric using stiffener as the stabilizer. Embroider a front and back piece.
2. Place the pattern on the fabric and draw around the edges of the pattern
3. Stitch the fabric to the stiffener 1/4" inside your drawn line
4. Cut the stiffener close to the stitching to eliminate extra bulk in your seams

5. Cut the fabric on the original drawn line making 2 pieces, each the exact shape of the pattern piece.
6. Cut two lining pieces using your pattern. You now have 4 pieces the exact same shape.
7. Place one lining and one of the embroidered pieces right sides together.
8. Repeat with the remaining embroidered piece and lining. You now have two grouped items, each with a lining piece and an embroidered piece
9. Stitch each of the 2 grouped pieces across the top only.

10. Place the two pieces you've made right sides together, embroidered piece to embroidered piece, lining piece to lining piece. Stitch around the embroidered pieces all the way around. Stitch around the lining leaving a space in the bottom for turning things right side out.

11. Close the bottom of the lining then stuff the lining inside the embroidered side.
12. Press the top edge
13. Following the instructions in the webinar, sew the frame to the body you've just constructed.
