Seven of Hearts is about exploring different vineyards, appellations, and varietals: cool-climate varietals from the Willamette Valley and warmweather varietals from the Columbia Valley, Oregon and Washington.

Using traditional winemaking methods, our goal is to produce sincere wines of purity, complexity, and character. We partner with growers who primarily farm organic and sustainably, and who are stewards of their land and vines, providing the attention to details that produce great fruit and capture the best qualities of each vintage.

The label on the bottle, with its neoclassical elements, symbolizes our passion for wines in the old-world tradition that reflect where they are from and the conditions under which they were grown.

LUMINOUS HILLS

Under out estate label, Luminous Hills, we produce Pinot noirs that are specific to a distinct place in the southwest corner of the Yamhill-Carlton AVA with a unique combination of aspects, two diverse and well-delineated soils, dramatic elevation changes, and carefully matched Pinot noir clones and rootstocks to each block of the vineyard. The wines produced from Luminous Hills capture the broad expression of the entire vineyard in the "silver label", the southwest aspect with emphasis on lower elevation sedimentary soil in the Lux, and the southeast aspect, higher elevation and volcanic soils in the Astra.

Planted in the sandy loam soils on Wahluke Slope in Columbia Valley Washington, this Tempranillo lived up to the meaning of its name "the early one" as our first pick of the season. Remarkably textured with firm tannins and spice, the StoneTree Vineyard delivers classic Temparnillo that we've shaped with a modest amount of new American Oak, emulating some of our favorite Tempranillos from the old world. Barreled 3 months in 16.5% new American Oak and 16.5% new French Oak, followed by 15 months in 16.5% new American Oak, 16.5% once filled French Oak, the remainder neutral French oak.
