PRODUCTION

All surgical instruments are made from high grade surgical stainless steel for professional use. All instruments are manufactured to high standards for safe use, conforming to industry standards, regulations and directives.

BlueKit Medical surgical instruments are used for intended surgical purposes, such as cutting, clamping, dissecting, exploring, retracting, irrigation, absorbing, suturing or ligature. Surgical instruments may be damaged if used for unintended purposes.

PROCESSING

BlueKit Medical single-use surgical instruments are physically inspected, ultrasonically washed and dried prior to any process of packaging and sterilisation. Effective sterility methods are judiciously applied, whether by Gamma Irradiation or Ethylene Oxide. We support regular testing for the sterility of products.

COMPLIANCE

All our instruments and consumables are manufactured to high standards and our associate manufacturing and processing companies are all ISO compliant. All BlueKit Medical surgical instruments are CE marked. We are proud to assert our standards: respectively, we are pleased to champion our products with our logo etched upon all our instruments.

STORAGE

- 2. Ensure all packs are kept in a storage area free of dust, insects, chemical vapours and extreme changes in temperature and humidity.
