



Digital Timer Relay Control of a Linear Actuator

Functionality:

In this wiring diagram a digital timer and a relay is used to control your linear actuator. After connecting the components you will be able to set the digital timer to extend/retract your actuator at specified intervals. Please note that this setup is in auto-retraction mode, such that when the digital timer is active (closed switch), the actuator will extend. When the digital timer is deactivated (open switch) the actuator will automatically retract.








Type: DPDT Relay, Non-Latching

Connection Point: COM / -V on



Type: Timer Switch No Connections: 4



Type: DC Motor, Bi-directional

No. Connections: 2
