VS350

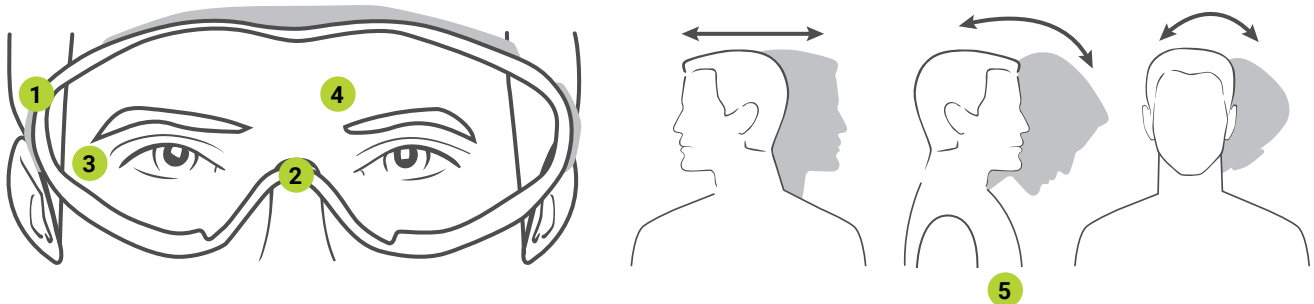
- Low profile, wraparound adaptive design fits a wide range of facial shapes

To ensure a proper fit, we recommend using our fit guide and reviewing eyewear descriptions and materials.



- 1 There should be no uncomfortable pressure points on the side of the head.
- 2 The nose piece should be comfortable and seal around your nose without pinching.
- 3 You should be able to see in all directions without major obstruction.
- 4 The soft TPE material should create a full seal without any gaps.
- 5 Head strap should be tightened so that the goggles stay in place when you move your head front to back and side to side.
