

What is this new resource?

Chicago Review Press has announced the release of *Discovering Great Artists, 2nd edition*. This textbook allows families to discover the process of art and explore 110 projects from Renaissance to modern great masters. Brief biographies are included with styles and techniques for each artist. The 144 page text is softbound and measures 11” x 8.5”.

Do customers need any additional supplies to be able to use the resource?

In addition to the textbook, common art supplies are needed:

- *Discovering Great Artists, 2nd edition* textbook
- Common art supply items such as scissors, paper, pencils, markers, paints, and brushes are needed for at-home projects.



How does the new resource compare with the old resource? The new second edition has been refreshed and redesigned to add color and reproductions of the “real” artwork from the great artists. The new edition includes:

- Full color throughout
- Reproductions of the "real" artwork
- New/revised activities
- Some first edition artists not included: Grandma Moses, Norman Rockwell
- Some new artists included: Arp, Nevelson, Hokusai, and Paik

Can siblings share the resource? Yes, this resource is non-consumable, and siblings may share the text.

How will this help families? Families with elementary aged children will benefit from the Icon Guide in this textbook. Icon graphics give families suggested experience and preparation level as well as the art technique and style for each project.

How can it be used at home? Families at home may use this resource to learn a brief biography about great masters and practice the artists’ styles and techniques by following the steps outlined in the textbook.
