



DESCRIPTION



Perma Satin Emulsion is a great quality paint offering a very durable low sheen finish for both interior and exterior surfaces. It is suitable for high traffic areas such as kitchens, bathrooms, patios, and children's rooms where easy cleaning is desirable.

It can be used on new and previously painted concrete, gypsum, wood, siding/trim and ceilings. As an exterior paint, it offers fungus protection and fade resistance and is recommended for areas where weathering can be problematic, such as coastal areas.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Perma Satin Emulsion may be applied by brush or roller. Mix thoroughly before use. Paint is supplied ready for use. Thinning is not necessary except when used as a primer or as a first coat on porous surfaces. If required, thin paint with a maximum of 250ml of water per 3.78L (1/2 pint of water per 1 US Gallon) of Perma Satin Emulsion. Generally, 2 or 3 coats of **Perma Satin Emulsion** will give a satisfactory finish.

GENERAL SURFACE PREPARATION

All surfaces must be sound, dry, clean and free of oil, grease, dirt, mildew, form release agents, curing compounds and loose and flaking paint.

NEW SURFACES

Concrete and Masonry: Allow to cure for at least 30 days before painting. Remove any loose aggregate from the surface and roughen the surface of slick, smooth concrete by acid etching. Ensure to carefully follow the manufacturer's application and safety instructions. Rinse thoroughly with water and allow to dry. Prime with this product or with Harris/BH Super Seal Premium Bonding Primer/Sealer or Ulttima Concrete & Drywall Primer.

Wood: Spot prime knots and sappy streaks with a shellac-based sealer. Sand the surface smooth and wipe clean. Prime surface with Super Grip Primer.

PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES

Wash and rinse thoroughly with water to remove any contaminants and allow to air dry. Remove all mildew by washing with a solution of 125ml liquid bleach and 15ml non-ammoniated liquid detergent per litre of water. Glossy areas must be sanded to a dull finish and wiped free of dust to provide best adhesion. Scrub heavily chalked or greasy areas with detergent and water and allow to air dry. Treat any remaining chalky surfaces with Harris/BH Super Seal before the application of this product. Prime bare areas with primer specified under **NEW SURFACES.**

DRYING TIME

Touch dry: 30 minutes Recoat: After 4 hours Curing time: 7 days

Clean tools and equipment with warm soapy water immediately after use.
