DESCRIPTION



Woodcare Maritime Spar Gloss Varnish is designed for exterior and interior marine, industrial and architectural use – any wood substrates requiring elasticity and resistance to corrosion, sea spray, humidity and chemical attacks.

Maritime Spar Gloss Varnish's clear finish, enhances the stained or natural beauty of wood and its UV inhibitors extend performance for years with normal servicing.

SPREAD RATE

RECOMMENDED MAXIMUM WET FILM THICKNESS PER COAT:

100 – 125 microns (4-5mils)

RECOMMENDED MINIMUM SPREAD RATE PER COAT:

 $7.8 - 9.8 \text{ m}^2$ per litre (320-400 sq ft/ US gal) dependent upon the nature and absorbency of the wood.

Number of Coats: 2– 4 for enhanced durability and service life for exterior applications.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Stir thoroughly before use.

Do not shake. Apply in a well-ventilated area.

Do not apply outside if rain is imminent with the next 12 hours.

Apply by brush, roller or spray at a rate of $9.3 - 11.6 \text{ m}^2 (100 - 125 \text{ ft}^2)$ per litre.

Thinning is not required but if desired thin up to 10% with Ulttima Puritene Oil Paint Thinner. For new wood or previously stained surfaces, up to four coats will be required to achieve maximum gloss and durability. For previously varnished surfaces, one or two coats will be required. Dry to touch in about 4 hours. Allow 8 hours drying time between coats. Sand lightly, between coats for best final appearance. Allow final coat on vertical surfaces to dry 24 hours before returning to service, and 48 hours for decks and floors.

GENERAL SURFACE PREPARATION

Surfaces should be clean, dry and free from dust, grease, oil and wax.

NEW SURFACES

Do not apply to surfaces coated with Harris WoodCare High-Performance Penetrating Stain within the last six (6) months.

For exterior surfaces, high-pressure wash, or wash with a solution of 125ml liquid bleach and 15 ml non- ammoniated detergent to 4 litres (1 gallon) of water, to remove any mildew or surface salts.

Allow the wood to dry out thoroughly before application of the Harris WoodCare Maritime Spar Gloss Varnish.

PREVIOUSLY PAINTED SURFACES

Sand thoroughly to remove any glossy, loose, flaking or peeling coating.

Surfaces in very bad condition or previously, varnished surfaces should be **completely stripped** of old coatings.

DRYING TIME

Allow 8 hours drying time between coats. For vertical surfaces allow 24 hours drying time before use. For horizontal surfaces allow 48 hours before use.

CLEAN- UP

Clean tools, equipment and spills with Ulttima Puritene Oil Paint Thinner. For best maintenance, after cleaning with thinner, wash brushes with warm water and detergent.
