

Jobsite Checklist

The following steps can help protect you, your crew and your customers from potential spread of covid-19.

PPE for everyone on jobsite
Cleaning & disinfecting supplies
Soap & paper towels at handwashing stations
Tepid water at handwashing
Trash cans emptied
Tissues stocked
Shared or high-touch surfaces cleaned & disinfected (tools, machines, vehicles, handrails, doorknobs, portable toilets)
All workers practicing social distancing (minimum 6 feet) at all times
Workers' temperature taken (morning, midday, end of day)
Workers symptom-free (CDC-listed symptoms include cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell)
Workers displaying fever or symptoms sent home
Larger jobsite (more than six people) has designated COVID-19 Site Supervisor
Daily attendance log of all workers and visitors updated (and retained at least four weeks)
