Jobsite Checklist

The following steps can help protect you, your crew and your customers from potential spread of covid-19.

- PPE for everyone on jobsite
- Cleaning & disinfecting supplies
- Soap & paper towels at handwashing stations
- Tepid water at handwashing
- Trash cans emptied
- Tissues stocked
- Shared or high-touch surfaces cleaned & disinfected (tools, machines, vehicles, handrails, doorknobs, portable toilets)
- All workers practicing social distancing (minimum 6 feet) at all times
- Workers' temperature taken (morning, midday, end of day)
- Workers symptom-free (CDC-listed symptoms include cough, shortness of breath, fever, chills, muscle pain, headache, sore throat, loss of taste or smell)
- Workers displaying fever or symptoms sent home
- Larger jobsite (more than six people) has designated COVID-19 Site Supervisor
- Daily attendance log of all workers and visitors updated (and retained at least four weeks)
