Going to Work

- Know the COVID-19 symptoms and stay home if you feel sick.
- Drive yourself but wear PPE if you must commute or rideshare.
- Keep your coffee, lunch and utensils clean and separate from others.
- Crew leaders and foremen should consider taking workers' temperatures first thing in the morning and possibly throughout the day.

At the Job

- Having the same crew start to finish is ideal
- Ask your Benjamin Moore retailer about product delivery, ideally 72 hours in advance.
- Wear PPE and be mindful of touching your face.
- Don't touch your eyes or mouth until you wash your hands.
- Each crew member should have their own workspace, six feet apart or in separate rooms.
- Visitors to the site must wear PPE, including clients and homeowners.

Break Times

- Everyone needs to stay six feet apart.
- Ideally, each worker takes their coffee or lunch breaks in their own vehicles.
- Wash your hands before and after each break.

Quittin' Time!

- Remove work clothes into a separate laundry system before entering your home.
- When you enter your home, go straight to the shower before touching anyone.

Know the COVID-19 Symptoms – They may include the following

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Fever
- Chills
- Muscle pain
- Headache
- Sore throat
- Loss of taste or smell
