

Safe handling, erecting and care guide for your deckchair





Wooden Deckchair Care Guide

This guide is designed to help you care for your deckchair looking as beautiful as possible, for as long as possible. For us, these are the key things.

1. Storage:

When not in use, ideally store your chair inside, in a dry location. Folding the deckchairs flat is really easy, but can be quite tricky at first. To help, keep the deckchair in the seated position, stand behind it and you should see a Southwesterly Logo engraved into the wood at the bottom of the deckchair. Now, take this and the supporting frame and raise it so it is brought up to the top of the chair. You should now have two supporting pieces of frame at the top, and one at the bottom and your chair should be flat. When not in use store in a dry place out of direct sunlight and make sure the sling is completely dry.

2. Maintenance:

The wood of the garden deckchair is a very hardwearing, sustainably sourced Beech hard wood. We have found that adding an oil to the wood every year or two enhances the frame. If your garden deckchair has suffered from a few scratches, a light sand and then application of wood oil will give your deck chair a new lease of life. All of our deckchair slings are a 100z Cotton Canvas dyed using environmentally friendly azo free water based inks which are UV resistant with an approx. 10% fade tolerance and machine washable.

3. Cleaning:

Should you wish to remove the deckchair sling and either wash, or store in a dry place over winter, position your deckchair in the seated position. Looking at it face on, head to the left hand side. You will find screws at the top and bottom of the base of the deckchair. Simply unscrew, prise apart the frame and slip the deck chair sling off. Remember that if the chair has been in damp conditions for a while, the wood may have expanded, meaning that pulling the chair apart is more difficult. Simply keep in a dry place for a few days before dismantling.




1 Lay the deckchair flat on the floor with the notches facing upwards




2 Hold the top bar with the fabric










IMPORTANT

Ensure the bar is fitted correctly in the notches to stop it collapsing



Bar fits snugly into the notches



Bar secured into the notches on both sides

To lower the chair, lift the bar from the notches and gently lower the chair to the ground
