4.1. Description of first aid measures

Wash with plenty of soap and water. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention. Specific treatment (see supplemental first aid instruction on this label). If skin irritation or rash occurs: Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin area with mild soap and water, followed by warm water rinse.

: Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if pain, blinking or

persists.

: Immediately call a poison center or doctor/physician. Rinse mouth. Do NOT

vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention.
