: Never give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. IF exposed or concerned: Get medical advice/attention. Call a poison center or a doctor if you feel unwell. If you feel unwell, seek medical advice (show the label where possible).

: Remove person to fresh air and keep comfortable for breathing. Allow affected person to breathe fresh air. Allow the victim to rest.

Remove affected clothing and wash all exposed skin area with mild soap and water, followed by warm water rinse. Wash with plenty of water/.... If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get immediate medical advice/attention. Get medical advice/attention. Specific treatment (see Wash skin with plenty of water on this label). Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. Wash skin with plenty of water. Take off contaminated clothing. If skin irritation or rash occurs: Get medical advice/attention. If skin irritation occurs: Get medical advice/attention.

: Rinse immediately with plenty of water. Obtain medical attention if pain, blinking or redness persists. Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention.

: Rinse mouth. Do NOT induce vomiting. Obtain emergency medical attention. Call a POISON CENTER/doctor if you feel unwell. Call a poison center or a doctor if you feel unwell.
